Survey Methodology



Civiqs polled 933 Democratic and Democratic-leaning Independent registered voters age 18-39 in Arizona, Florida, Georgia, Michigan, Minnesota, North Carolina, New Hampshire, Pennsylvania, Texas, and Wisconsin from September 8-12, 2020.

The survey was conducted online, among selected members of the Civiqs research panel.

Survey results are weighted by age, race, gender, education, party identification, and state. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 3.7\%$.




Which of the following issues is the most important to you in the upcoming November election?








When thinking about addressing changes to the economy, which of the following do you think is most important to address?



Support for reparations among Black voters




When thinking about addressing changes to the economy, which of the following do you think is most important to address?

When thinking about addressing changes to the economy, which of the following do you think is **second** most important to address?




Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Joe Biden?

Biden favorability gains among younger white voters






Does Joe Biden picking Kamala Harris as his Vice Presidential nominee make you more or less likely to vote for Joe Biden?


What issue do you think is most important for Vice President Biden to discuss during the first Presidential debate on September 29th?



Very unfavorable attitudes towards President Trump




Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Donald Trump?



Attitudes towards President Trump, by race




Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Donald Trump?



Independents only slightly less unfavorable of Trump




Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Donald Trump?

If the general election for President were held today, who would you vote for?



Biden campaign contact increased since August









Voter turnout: Most people live where they are voting






Are you living where you are registered to vote?




If you plan to vote by mail in your state, when do you plan to return your ballot?



Mail voters divided on safest method




If you plan to vote by mail in your state, which of the following do you feel is the most secure way to return your ballot?
