Civiqs polled 1,047 Democratic and Democratic-leaning Independent registered voters age 18-39 in Arizona, Florida, Georgia, Michigan, Minnesota, North Carolina, New Hampshire, Pennsylvania, Texas, and Wisconsin from October 8-12, 2020.

The survey was conducted online, among selected members of the Civiqs research panel.

Survey results are weighted by age, race, gender, education, party identification, and state. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 3.7\%$.




Which of the following issues is the most important to you in the upcoming November election?














Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Joe Biden?






Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Kamala Harris?








What effect does Kamala Harris being selected as Joe Biden's Vice President have on who you're voting for President?




Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Donald Trump?






Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Donald Trump?



High-turnout voters support Biden most strongly




If the general election for President were held today, who would you vote for?






If Joe Biden becomes President, do you support Democrats adding four additional justices to the Supreme Court, raising the number of justices to 13?



Congressional GOP blamed on lack of COVID relief




Who do you consider responsible for there not being an additional COVID relief bill passed by the federal government?



First 100 Days: Raise taxes on wealthy




If Democrats gain control of the Senate after the 2020 election, which of the following would you most like to see them do in the first 100 days of the next Congress?






